Qualifications:

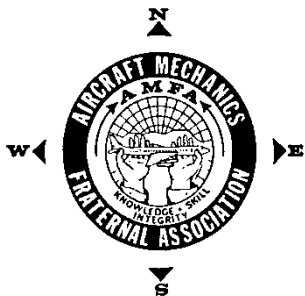
- Applicant must be enrolled as a student in an A&P school or university attempting to obtain their A&P license
- Applicant must be a U.S. citizen
- Applicant must demonstrate a passion for the craft as demonstrated in a 500-word essay expressing what "safety in the air begins with quality maintenance on the ground" means to them

- Completed applications must be submitted to AMFA National via email to finance@amfanatl.org or fax to 303-362-7736, including:
 1. Application Form
 2. 500-word essay expressing what "safety in the air begins with quality maintenance on the ground" means to you
 3. Applicant must send transcripts proving current enrollment and grades
- Applications are due no later than February 28, 2019.
